Steps to follow to get started:

Ensure the Kami Chrome extension is installed in on all students and teachers devices.

Here are the instructions on how to get started with Kami:

1. Create a Kami login using the email address (either one provided to us in a.csv file or school email)
2. Install the Kami Chrome extension (<https://kami.app/extension>)
3. Connect Kami to Google Drive (<https://help.kamiapp.com/google-chrome-and-google-drive/how-do-i-open-a-file-from-google-drive>)
4. Open Kami
